# Requirements for 2025 The Manuel G. Balelo and Norine Marroquin Memorial PHC Scholarship

Applications will not be accepted after **June 30, 2025**, and it will be considered invalid if the required supporting documents are missing or if the specified requirements are not met.

- 1. Applicant must be of Portuguese descent
- 2. **Sponsor/Member** must be a Parent, Grandparent, or Great-grandparent and a member of the Portuguese Historical Center (PHC).
- 3. **Sponsor/Member** must be a member in good standing of the PHC for no less than 12 months (minimum of one year, preceding in January).
- 4. The applicant must be a graduating senior at the time of application and/or have graduated from high school during the current year.
- 5. The applicant must have maintained a minimum of a **3.00 Grade Point Average** (2.50 if applicant has a documented learning disability) throughout their high school career, with an *official transcript*.
- 6. V<u>erifiable</u> volunteer experience within the past two years in the San Diego Portuguese community.
- The applicant must meet all requirements for admission to an accredited college, university, or trade school of their choice.
- 8. Applicant must present two (2) (minimum) Letters of Recommendation from individuals who will vouch for the candidate's academic standing, character, and school activity record. The letters <u>must</u> be from: (A) a teacher at the high school attended; and (B) any other source <u>except a relative</u> (i.e. a coach, instructor, mentor etc.). Individuals must type letters and must <u>include</u> their titles and relationships. Requesting letters as early as possible is recommended.
- 9. Any award will be made on a competitive basis, with consideration given to scholastic attainment, character, and promise. The donors of this award intend to assist students who have demonstrated ability and a sincere purpose in securing an education.
- 10.A \$1,000.00 scholarship will be granted to the successful applicant, with payment being made specifically to the student. Other stipulations include:

#### A COMPLETED APPLICATION PACKET SHOULD INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS:

- Scholarship Application signed and dated
- 2 years Portuguese Community Service Activity Worksheet/Letter(s)
- School Transcripts

- Personal Statement: What business or profession are you preparing for, and why?
- Two (2) Letters of Recommendation as outlined above

# Requirements for 2025 The Manuel G. Balelo and Norine Marroquin Memorial PHC Scholarship

## **Activity Summary Requirements:**

- 1. Summarize in writing your principal activities and extracurricular interests during high school, include any leadership positions. (Must be typed on an additional sheet of paper).
- 2. Summarize your San Diego Community Service outside of the Portuguese Community (Must be typed on an additional sheet of paper).
- 3. Summarize your service to and involvement in the Portuguese San Diego Community (Must be typed on an additional sheet of paper).

#### **Personal Statement**

Your Personal Statement should be a **maximum of 150 words** on a separate typed paper and answer the following question:

For what business or profession are you preparing, and why?

### **Recommendation Letters**

<u>Two</u> (2) letters of recommendation must be submitted on behalf of each Applicant. One of the letters of recommendation must be from a teacher at the high school attended, explaining character and academic standing. The second letter must be from any source *except* a relative. (i.e. coach, instructor, mentor, etc.).
